You see, it only takes a word on our part because the risen Lord is at work. We can't save anyone! We cannot make anyone believe or have faith! That is the Lord's job! And the Lord is at work ahead of us, before we ever say a word... but without the focus of a faithful word, sinful people will most often not see it.

Enjoy May! Enjoy busy! Enjoy people and games and gatherings! Listen and look for where the Lord is at work around you.... And then be who you are in Christ Jesus! Be a faithful child of God and make mention of what you see! Provide that faithful Word that can be the hook for the Holy Spirit's working of faith!
